

Department Head --- Oklahoma State University

The Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders at Oklahoma State University invites applications for the position of professor and department head, subject to availability of funds, to begin July 1, 2010 or as negotiated. Applicants must hold a doctorate in communication sciences and disorders or a closely related field, be eligible for appointment as full professor with tenure, and have experience as an administrator within an academic unit. The successful candidate should have credentials demonstrating excellence in teaching, scholarly activities, and academic administration.

OSU is a comprehensive university with an enrollment of 21,000 students. The Department of Communication and Sciences and Disorders offers a B.S and M.S. in Speech-Language Pathology and is accredited by the Council on Academic Accreditation of the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association. Currently there are approximately 120 undergraduate majors and 40 graduate students enrolled on the Stillwater and Tulsa campuses. In October 2009, the department moved into a new, state-of-the-art academic and clinical facility on the Stillwater campus and has also recently moved into a newly renovated clinical facility on the Tulsa campus.

The position will remain open until filled with initial application review beginning January 15, 2010. Salary is competitive and dependent on experience and qualifications.
